Choose 4 of the 5 Questions:

1. Which part of our founding documents do you think most successfully addresses grievances? Use evidence from the lesson in your response.
2. What additional amendment would you add to the Constitution? Explain the reasoning behind your decision.
3. How did colonial grievances influence the creation of the government structures in the United States?
4. How does the government today handle grievances at the state and/or federal level?
5. How effective do you think the U.S. government has been over time in addressing grievances compared to the colonial period? Use at least one historical and one modern example to support your answer.
